

The House Committee on Insurance offers the following substitute to HB 529:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Titles 33 and 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance  
2 and motor vehicles and traffic, respectively, so as to provide for minimum amounts of  
3 uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage to be maintained by transportation network  
4 companies; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date and applicability;  
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance, is amended in Code  
9 Section 33-1-24, relating to insurance requirements for transportation network companies  
10 and their drivers, by revising subsection (b) as follows:

11 "(b) A transportation network company shall maintain or cause to be maintained a primary  
12 motor vehicle insurance policy that:

13 (1) Recognizes the driver as a transportation network company driver and explicitly  
14 covers the driver's provision of transportation network company services as defined in  
15 paragraph (5) of subsection (a) of this Code section;

16 (2) During the time period defined in subparagraph (a)(5)(A) of this Code section,  
17 provides a minimum of \$100,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of all persons in any  
18 one accident with a maximum of \$50,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of one person  
19 and \$50,000.00 for loss of or damage to property of others, excluding cargo, in any one  
20 accident; and

21 (3) During the time period defined in subparagraph (a)(5)(B) of this Code section,  
22 provides a minimum of \$1 million for death, personal injury, and property damage per  
23 occurrence and provides uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage ~~of at least~~  
24 \$1 million as required by Code Section 33-7-11, with minimum limits of \$300,000.00 for  
25 bodily injuries to or death of all persons in any one accident with a maximum of  
26 \$100,000.00 for bodily injuries to or death of one person and \$25,000.00 for loss of or  
27 damage to property of others, excluding cargo, in any one accident."

28 **SECTION 2.**

29 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2023, and shall apply to causes of action accruing  
30 on or after July 1, 2023.

31 **SECTION 3.**

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
