

ADOPTED

Senators Parent of the 42nd and Brass of the 28th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the substitute to SB 86 (LC 49 1333S) by inserting after line 6: "to provide for targets;*
2 *to provide for data collection and reporting; to provide for rules and regulations;"*

3 *By inserting after line 48 the following:*

4 **SECTION 2.**

5 Said part is further amended in Code Section 20-2-161.3, relating to the "Dual Enrollment
6 Act," purpose, dual credit courses, eligibility for participation, and eligibility for payment,
7 by adding new subsections to read as follows:

8 "(p) The department shall establish participation and performance targets, including, but
9 not limited to, targets to increase participation and success among underrepresented groups.

10 (q)(1) Data collected or reported under this subsection shall be disaggregated by race,
11 gender, ethnicity, economic status, grade level, and location.

12 (2) The department and any organization that receives program funds shall annually
13 report to the commission, at a minimum, the following data:

14 (A) Rates of participation, dual credit earned, and attempted but uncompleted courses;

15 (B) Rates of college enrollment and graduation for participating students; and

16 (C) Correlation between completion of eligible dual credit courses and the time to
17 complete a college degree program.

18 (3) The commission shall maintain and annually report to the Governor and the General
19 Assembly data for the three preceding school years, including, at a minimum, the data
20 reported under paragraph (2) of this subsection and:

21 (A) Common factors in attempted but uncompleted eligible dual credit courses;

22 (B) Measures of meeting or exceeding program objectives and targets; and

23 (C) Cost savings resulting from the program.

24 (4) The commission is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations as necessary to
25 implement this subsection."

26 *By redesignating Sections 2 and 3 as Sections 3 and 4, respectively.*
