## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Alexandra Papadopoulou and inviting her to be recognized by the Senate; and  
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alexandra Papadopoulou has long been recognized by the people of Greece for  
4 the vital role that she has played in leadership and her deep personal commitment to the  
5 welfare of her fellow citizens; and

6 WHEREAS, she has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of her time,  
7 talents, and energy toward the betterment of her country, as evidenced by her superlative  
8 service as ambassador; and

9 WHEREAS, appointed as ambassador of Greece to the United States in 2019, Alexandra  
10 Papadopoulou previously served as head of the Diplomatic Cabinet of the Greek Prime  
11 Minister, permanent representative of Greece to the European Union, head of the Greek

18 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved

20 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
21 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

22 WHEREAS, Alexandra Papadopoulou has served with honor and distinction, and her vision  
23 and unyielding commitment to excellence have set the standard for public service; and

24 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
25 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
27 commend Alexandra Papadopoulou for her efficient, effective, unselfish, and dedicated  
28 public service; invite her to be recognized by the Senate on March 7, 2023; and extend the
