A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing Mr. Kaleb Driggers and dedicating a road in his honor; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Mr. Kaleb Driggers graduated from Baconton Community Charter School in
3 Baconton, Georgia, and attended East Mississippi Community College; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Driggers has long been recognized for his talent and passion in the amateur
5 and professional rodeo communities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, prior to going pro, Mr. Driggers was recognized as the National High School
7 Finals Rodeo All-Around Rookie of the Year in 2005; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 2009, Mr. Driggers was honored by the Professional Rodeo Cowboy
9 Association as Rookie of the Year in overall and team roping; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he is a two-time Team Roping World Champion, earning back-to-back titles in
11 2021 and 2022; and
- 12 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
13 Georgian be recognized appropriately by dedicating a road in his honor.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
15 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the portion of State Route 82 from 500 feet from the
16 western boundary of Hoboken and 500 feet from the eastern boundary of Hoboken in
17 Brantley County is dedicated as the Kaleb Driggers Highway.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
19 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Kaleb Driggers Highway.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
21 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mr.
22 Kaleb Driggers and to the Department of Transportation.
