A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Elder Henry Frasier, Sr.; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Elder Henry Frasier, Sr., was born on June 7, 1932, in Taylors' Creek, Georgia,
3 and at an early age, moved with his parents, five brothers, and two sisters to Liberty County;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, he was educated in the Liberty County School System and in June of 2022 was
6 the recipient of an Honorary Doctorate Degree from Trinity Temple College of Religion; and

7 WHEREAS, he was employed by the Hinesville Bank and Bradwell Institute; and

8 WHEREAS, he began his ministry in 1972 at Pleasant Grove AME Church, Hinesville,
9 Georgia, and has spent a lifetime answering God's call to be His messenger to do His will,
10 continuing on with a weekly radio broadcast, "Church-in" with Elder Frasier, on WGML
11 990; and

12 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,
13 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced by his
14 service as mayor and councilman City of Walthourville; chairman of the Advisory Council

15 Members for the Area Agency on Aging; chairperson of the Juvenile Court Panel; member
16 of the Frasier Center Council Support Board; and member of Walthourville Senior Citizens
17 and he is also a life member of the NAACP and the Liberty County Democratic Party
18 Committee; and

19 WHEREAS, his vision and direction have earned him such accolades as being named SED
20 Minister of the Year Award 1997 and Grand Marshal of the MLK Day Parade 2009 and
21 receiving the Ralph W. Quarterman Award for Civil Rights Involvement in 2016; and

22 WHEREAS, he has been united in love and marriage to Leary Mae Hendry Frasier since
23 1956, and this union has been blessed with six boys and four girls, 36 grandchildren, 38
24 great-grandchildren, and two great-great grandchildren; and

25 WHEREAS, this distinguished gentleman has given inspiration to many through his high
26 ideals, morals, and deep concern for his fellow citizens, and he possesses the vast wisdom
27 which only comes through experience and the strength of character which is achieved
28 through overcoming the many challenges of life; and

29 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
30 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
