House Bill 1183 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to student health in elementary and secondary education, so as to require local school systems to provide certain information to parents and guardians of students in grades six through 12 on Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes whenever other health information is provided; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 Part 3 of Article 16 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, 9 relating to student health in elementary and secondary education, is amended by revising 10 Code Section 20-2-771.1, designated as reserved, as follows: "20-2-771.1. 11 12 (a) If a local board of education provides information on immunizations, infectious 13 diseases, medications, or other school health issues to parents and guardians of students in 14 grades six through 12, then the following information about Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes 15 shall be included: 16 (1) A description of Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes;

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17	(2) A description of the risk factors and warning signs associated with Type 1 and
18	<u>Type 2 diabetes;</u>
19	(3) A recommendation to the parent or guardian of those students displaying warning
20	signs associated with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes that such parent or guardian consult with
21	the student's primary care provider to determine if immediate screening for Type 1 or
22	<u>Type 2 diabetes is appropriate:</u>
23	(4) A description of the screening processes for both Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes and of
24	the significance of the stages of Type 1 diabetes; and
25	(5) A recommendation that, following a Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes diagnosis, the parent
26	or guardian consult with the student's primary care provider to develop an appropriate
27	treatment plan.
28	(b) The Department of Education, in cooperation with the Department of Public Health,
29	shall develop and make available the information about Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes to local
30	school systems as required under subsection (a) of this Code section in an efficient manner
31	that shall include posting the information on its public website. Reserved."

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SECTION 2.

33 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
