- of 26,000 pounds, any;
- 14 (B) Any three-wheeled motor vehicle that is equipped with a steering wheel for
- directional control, and any; and
- 16 (C) Any self-propelled or towed vehicle that is equipped to serve as temporary living
- quarters for recreational, camping, or travel purposes and is used solely as a family or
- personal conveyance; except that any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle
- weight rating not in excess of 26,000 pounds may be operated under such class of
- 20 license if such combination of vehicles are controlled and operated by a farmer, used
- 21 to transport agricultural products, livestock, farm machinery, or farm supplies to or
- from a farm, and are not used in the operations of a common or contract carrier
- regardless of the gross vehicle weight rating or combined gross vehicle weight rating;

- 24 (2) Class D =: Provisional license applicable to noncommercial Class C vehicles for

- 26 (3) Class E =: Any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001
- pounds or more, provided that the gross vehicle weight rating of the vehicle or vehicles
- being towed is in excess of 10,000 pounds, and all vehicles included within Class F and
- 29 Class C and the vehicle or vehicles are operated by a farmer to transport agricultural
- products, livestock, farm machinery, or farm supplies to or from a farm and are not used
- in the operations of a common or contract carrier;
- 32 (4) Class F =: Any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds
- or more, or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating not in
- excess of 10,000 pounds, and all vehicles included within Class C;
- 35 (5) Class M =: Motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and three-wheeled motorcycles
- 36 equipped with handlebars for directional control; and
