Senator Tillery of the 19th offered the following amendment #1:

1 *Amend the substitute to HB 926 (LC 48 1298S) by inserting the following line 212 and*
 2 *renumbering the remaining Section:*

3 Said title is further amended in Code Section 40-5-23, relating to classes of drivers' licenses,
 4 by revising subsections (c) and (d) as follows:

5 "(c) The noncommercial classes of motor vehicles for which operators may be licensed
 6 shall be as follows:

7 (1) Class C ==:

8 (A) Any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating not in excess of 26,000
 9 pounds, any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating not in
 10 excess of 10,000 pounds, ~~or~~ any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a gross vehicle
 11 weight rating in excess of 10,000 pounds, provided that ~~the~~ any combination of vehicles
 12 set forth in this subparagraph has a gross combined vehicle weight rating not in excess
 13 of 26,000 pounds, ~~any;~~

14 (B) Any three-wheeled motor vehicle that is equipped with a steering wheel for
 15 directional control, ~~and any; and~~

16 (C) Any self-propelled or towed vehicle that is equipped to serve as temporary living
 17 quarters for recreational, camping, or travel purposes and is used solely as a family or
 18 personal conveyance; ~~except that any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle~~
 19 ~~weight rating not in excess of 26,000 pounds may be operated under such class of~~
 20 ~~license if such combination of vehicles are controlled and operated by a farmer, used~~
 21 ~~to transport agricultural products, livestock, farm machinery, or farm supplies to or~~
 22 ~~from a farm, and are not used in the operations of a common or contract carrier~~
 23 ~~regardless of the gross vehicle weight rating or combined gross vehicle weight rating;~~

- 24 (2) Class D ==: Provisional license applicable to noncommercial Class C vehicles for
25 which an applicant desires a driver's license but is not presently licensed to drive;
- 26 (3) Class E ==: Any combination of vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001
27 pounds or more, provided that the gross vehicle weight rating of the vehicle or vehicles
28 being towed is in excess of 10,000 pounds, ~~and all vehicles included within Class F and~~
29 ~~Class C~~ and the vehicle or vehicles are operated by a farmer to transport agricultural
30 products, livestock, farm machinery, or farm supplies to or from a farm and are not used
31 in the operations of a common or contract carrier;
- 32 (4) Class F ==: Any single vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 pounds
33 or more; or any such vehicle towing a vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating not in
34 excess of 10,000 pounds, ~~and all vehicles included within Class C;~~
- 35 (5) Class M ==: Motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and three-wheeled motorcycles
36 equipped with handlebars for directional control; and
- 37 (6) Class P ==: Instruction permit applicable to all types of vehicles for which an
38 applicant desires a driver's license but is not presently licensed to drive.
- 39 (d) Any applicant for a Class E or Class F license ~~must~~ shall possess a valid Georgia
40 driver's license for Class C vehicles. A license issued pursuant to this Code section shall
41 not be a commercial driver's license."
