

Senator Watson of the 11th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Committee on Economic Development and Tourism substitute to HB 1048*
2 *(LC 46 0884S) by replacing lines 1 through 5 with the following:*

3 To amend Chapter 3 and Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
4 relating to state flag, seal, and other symbols and the Department of Economic Development,
5 respectively, so as to promote economic development in this state through the recognition
6 and promotion of certain historically significant events, symbols, and industries; to designate
7 cornbread as the official state bread; to provide for placement of a Revolutionary War
8 Patriots marker upon the grounds of the state capitol building and upon the grounds of the
9 state archives building; to provide for the approval, placement, and procurement of such
10 markers; to enact the "Georgia State-wide Music Office Act"; to provide for legislative

11 *By replacing lines 35 and 36 with the following:*

12 Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state flag, seal,
13 and other symbols, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

14 *By replacing lines 41 and 42 with the following:*

15 Chapter 3 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to state flag, seal,
16 and other symbols, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:

"ARTICLE 818 50-3-130.

19 (a) There shall be placed upon the grounds of the state capitol building and upon the
20 grounds outside the state archives building a marker which commemorates the patriots of
21 the Revolutionary War, honoring the men and women who helped America achieve
22 independence. Each such marker shall honor the two-hundred and fiftieth anniversary of
23 the United States and those who fought for the noble cause of liberty and for a new nation.

24 (b) Placement location for Revolutionary War Patriots markers provided for in this Code
25 section shall be subject to approval by the Capitol Arts Standards Commission for
26 placement upon the grounds of the state capitol building and by the Board of Regents for
27 the placement of the marker upon the grounds outside the state archives building.

28 (c) No public funds shall be expended for the design or procurement of the markers
29 provided for in this Code section. Each such marker shall be placed as soon as practicable."

SECTION 3-1.

32 Chapter 7 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department
33 of Economic Development, is amended by revising Article 10, which is reserved, as follows:

34 *By replacing line 67 with the following:*

35 (6) 'Implement' and 'implementation' means and includes planning, writing, drafting,
36 designing.

37 *By replacing line 71 with the following:*

38 (7) 'Market' and 'marketing' means and includes promotion, advertising, signage, public
39 relations.
