8 Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to criminal procedure, is 9 amended in Code Section 17-4-23, relating to procedure for arrests by citation for motor 10 vehicle violations, issuance of warrants for arrest for failure of persons charged to appear in 11 court, and bond, by revising paragraph (2) of subsection (a) as follows:

12 "(2) A law enforcement officer may arrest a person who meets the minimum age 13 requirements provided for in Code Section 16-3-1 accused of any misdemeanor violation 14 of Code Section 16-7-21, 16-8-14, 16-8-14.1, or 16-13-30 by the issuance of a citation, 15 provided that such offense is committed in his or her presence or information constituting a basis for such arrest was received by the arresting officer or an investigating officer 16 17 from another law enforcement officer or other individual observing or aware of such offense being committed. When an arrest is made for such offense, prior to releasing the 18 19 accused on citation, the arresting law enforcement officer shall review the accused's criminal record as such is on file with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the 20 21 Georgia Crime Information Center within the Georgia Bureau of Investigation and ensure 22 that the accused's fingerprints are obtained."
