A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Habitat for Humanity Georgia and its Georgia affiliates and recognizing March
2 5, 2025, as Habitat for Humanity Georgia Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity Georgia and its Georgia affiliates have been steadfast
4 advocates for affordable housing and community development, tirelessly working to provide
5 safe and decent housing for families in need; and

6 WHEREAS, Habitat for Humanity Georgia and its Georgia affiliates' efforts have
7 significantly contributed to the well-being and stability of countless communities across the
8 state; and

9 WHEREAS, on March 5, 2025, Habitat for Humanity Georgia and its Georgia affiliates will
10 undertake a significant advocacy initiative by framing a house on the Georgia State Capitol
11 grounds, symbolizing the importance of affordable housing and the need for continued
12 support and legislative action; and

13 WHEREAS, this event will bring together volunteers, community leaders, and legislators to
14 raise awareness and demonstrate the collective commitment to addressing housing challenges
15 in Georgia; and

16 WHEREAS, the framing of this house on the state capitol grounds serves as a powerful
17 reminder of the impact that collaborative efforts can have in creating positive change and
18 fostering stronger, more resilient communities.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend Habitat for Humanity Georgia and its Georgia affiliates
21 for their unwavering dedication to affordable housing and community advocacy as well as
22 recognize March 5, 2025, as Habitat for Humanity Georgia Day at the state capitol.
