

House Resolution 1107

### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and supporting the Family Restoration and Re-Entry Program as a  
2 comprehensive framework for restoring families and communities; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, strong families are the cornerstone of stable communities, economic vitality,  
4 and long-term societal well-being, and the restoration of families is essential to reducing  
5 recidivism, poverty, and generational disruption; and

6 WHEREAS, individuals, women, youth, and families impacted by incarceration, economic  
7 displacement, domestic instability, trauma, and systemic barriers often face limited access  
8 to education, employment, entrepreneurship, leadership development, and pathways to  
9 family reunification; and

10 WHEREAS, Trinity International University of Ambassadors Corp. (FL), together with its  
11 affiliate, the Trinity International University of Ambassadors (TIUA) School of Business,  
12 has demonstrated a longstanding commitment to education, leadership development,  
13 entrepreneurship, workforce readiness, and community-based empowerment initiatives that  
14 strengthen individuals, families, and communities; and

15 WHEREAS, the TIUA School of Business serves as the academic and economic engine for  
16 entrepreneurial training, workforce development, financial literacy, and business ownership  
17 pathways that enable individuals and families to achieve sustainable economic independence;  
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the Family Restoration and Re-Entry Program serves as the overarching  
20 framework under which education, workforce reintegration, entrepreneurship, leadership  
21 development, and family reunification initiatives operate, with Trinity International  
22 University of Ambassadors Corp. (FL) and the TIUA School of Business providing  
23 structured learning, credentialing, mentorship, and business development opportunities for  
24 justice-impacted individuals and families; and

25 WHEREAS, this program is intentionally designed to bring the family together all the way  
26 around, integrating education, entrepreneurship, employment pathways, emotional  
27 restoration, accountability, youth engagement, and generational sustainability to strengthen  
28 families as unified economic and social units; and

29 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network Corp., a community-based nonprofit organization  
30 dedicated to empowering girls, women, and families, plays a vital role in advancing youth  
31 development, women's leadership, mentoring, life-skills education, advocacy, and  
32 community outreach as part of the Family Restoration and Re-Entry Program; and

33 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network Corp. provides on-the-ground programming and  
34 supportive services addressing the needs of girls and women impacted by trauma, economic  
35 instability, family separation, and social inequities, thereby strengthening family units and  
36 supporting long-term restoration; and

37 WHEREAS, the RebuildHER Initiative, operating within the Family Restoration and  
38 Re-Entry framework and anchored in the educational and economic infrastructure of Trinity  
39 International University of Ambassadors Corp. (FL) and the TIUA School of Business,  
40 addresses the unique challenges faced by women and mothers impacted by justice  
41 involvement, domestic abuse, economic hardship, and disrupted educational or career  
42 pathways; and

43 WHEREAS, the RebuildHER Initiative equips women to rebuild confidence, capacity,  
44 purpose, and leadership through education, entrepreneurship, healing-centered support, and  
45 pathways to financial independence, recognizing women and mothers as catalysts for family  
46 and community transformation; and

47 WHEREAS, the GlobalHER Initiative, advancing the theme "Empowering Her Justice," is  
48 intentionally aligned with the 70th Session of the United Nations Commission on the Status  
49 of Women (CSW70) and related United Nations global engagements taking place March  
50 11-15, 2026, reinforcing a shared commitment to justice-centered solutions that restore  
51 families, empower women and girls, support re-entry and economic inclusion, and advance  
52 education- and entrepreneurship-driven pathways at the local, national, and global levels; and

53 WHEREAS, The Organization of World Leaders provides global leadership engagement,  
54 policy alignment, international collaboration, and advocacy support that elevates family  
55 restoration, re-entry, women's empowerment, and youth development initiatives within  
56 broader national and global conversations on justice, economic inclusion, ethical governance,  
57 and sustainable development; and

58 WHEREAS, together, Trinity International University of Ambassadors Corp. (FL), the TIUA  
59 School of Business, Trinity Girls Network Corp., and The Organization of World Leaders

60 form an integrated education-to-community-to-leadership model that aligns local family  
61 restoration efforts with national priorities and global leadership principles through  
62 cross-sector collaboration; and

63 WHEREAS, these combined initiatives advance broader public goals including workforce  
64 development, small business growth, women's and youth empowerment, family reunification,  
65 reduced recidivism, ethical leadership development, and global civic engagement.

66 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
67 the members of this body commend Trinity International University of Ambassadors Corp.  
68 (FL) and the TIUA School of Business as the educational and economic backbone of the  
69 Family Restoration and Re-Entry Program and the RebuildHER Initiative; further recognize  
70 Trinity Girls Network Corp. for its essential role in community engagement, youth and  
71 women's empowerment, and family-centered restoration; and acknowledge The Organization  
72 of World Leaders for its role in advancing global leadership, policy alignment, and  
73 international collaboration in support of these initiatives.

74 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this body encourages collaboration among educational  
75 institutions, nonprofit organizations, workforce agencies, community and faith-based  
76 partners, leadership organizations, and public and private stakeholders to support and expand  
77 these initiatives as scalable models for family restoration, re-entry success, women-and-  
78 youth-centered economic rebuilding, and global leadership engagement.

79 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
80 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Trinity  
81 International University of Ambassadors Corp. (FL), the TIUA School of Business, Trinity  
82 Girls Network Corp., The Organization of World Leaders, and their community partners.
