## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Ernest "Ernie" Broadwell and recognizing February 9, 2026, as Fayette County  
2 Day at the Capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Fayette County Democratic Committee (FCDC) is an organization known  
4 for its grassroots resilience, community building, and the tireless dedication of its members  
5 who believe in creating a political home for Democrats in a rapidly changing Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, under the guiding hand of Ernest "Ernie" Broadwell, the FCDC has grown into  
7 a vibrant, diverse organization that advocates for progress in one of Georgia's most dynamic

22 of inclusion, grassroots organizing, and civic participation will continue to influence future  
23 generations; and

24 WHEREAS, today, the FCDC stands as a testament to this legacy, serving as a vibrant and  
25 diverse organization that advocates for progress, civic engagement, and democratic values  
26 in one of Georgia's most dynamic counties.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
28 commend Ernest "Ernie" Broadwell for his unwavering dedication to public service and  
29 recognize February 9, 2026, as Fayette County Day at the capitol.
