A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Georgia Advancing Communities Together, Inc., and
2 designating February 25, 2026, as Georgia ACT Housing Day at the Capitol; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, Georgia Advancing Communities Together, Inc., (Georgia ACT) is a statewide
5 member organization for nonprofit affordable housing and community development
6 organizations; and

7 WHEREAS, stable and affordable housing is a proven foundation for improved health,
8 educational outcomes, and economic mobility, and reducing homelessness benefits
9 communities socially and economically; and

10 WHEREAS, Georgia ACT focuses on connecting and convening Community Development
11 Corporations and nonprofits to address needs and build organizational capacity to improve
12 life outcomes for residents in communities across Georgia and leverage limited resources for
13 Georgia families; and

14 WHEREAS, Georgia ACT continues to advocate for the development of safe and decent
15 housing in Georgia while ensuring neighborhoods remain a catalyst for revitalization in all
16 communities; and

17 WHEREAS, Georgia ACT will host its 2026 Housing Day at the Capitol on February 25,
18 2026, providing an opportunity for members of the General Assembly to hear directly from
19 constituents and housing practitioners about the importance of expanding housing supply,
20 preventing homelessness, and supporting community development.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 recognize and commend Georgia Advancing Communities Together, Inc., and designate
23 February 25, 2026, as Georgia ACT Housing Day at the Capitol.
