A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life of Mr. Richard Keith "Rick" Worley and dedicating an intersection in his
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Richard Keith "Rick" Worley devoted his life and career to the community
4 of Catoosa County and Ringgold, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, a native of Catoosa County and cornerstone to his community, Mr. Worley
6 graduated from Ringgold High School and successfully owned and operated the Rick Worley
7 and Son Autobody shop; and

8 WHEREAS, after the tragic passing of his son in 2010, Mr. Worley established the Hunter
9 Worley Foundation which assists grieving parents in North Georgia and Tennessee Valley
10 with funeral and burial expenses; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Worley gave selflessly to his local community through his work sponsoring
12 numerous fundraising efforts at Graysville Elementary School and local middle and high
13 schools in Catoosa County; and

14 WHEREAS, he provided professional services to local police and fire departments and
15 frequently donated equipment and drivers for community parades; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that this remarkable and distinguished
17 Georgian be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in his memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 3/US-41 and Chapman Road
20 in Catoosa County is dedicated as the Richard Keith "Rick" Worley Memorial Intersection.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
22 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Richard Keith "Rick" Worley
23 Memorial Intersection.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
25 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the family of Mr.
26 Richard Keith "Rick" Worley and to the Department of Transportation.
