## A RESOLUTION

1 Creating the House Study Committee on the College and Career Ready Performance Index  
2 (CCRPI); and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI) is Georgia's tool for  
4 measuring how well public schools, local school systems, and the state are preparing students  
5 for the next level of education; and

6 WHEREAS, the CCRPI includes five main components, each of which is intended to  
7 measure a particular aspect of college and career readiness: content mastery, progress,  
8 closing gaps, readiness, and graduation rate; and

9 WHEREAS, it is essential that the components of the CCRPI are reliable and accurate  
10 indicators of college and career readiness; and

11 WHEREAS, the content mastery component is intended to measure whether students are  
12 achieving at the level necessary to be prepared for the next grade, college, or a career; and

13 WHEREAS, the progress component is intended to measure how much growth students  
14 demonstrate from one school year to the next; and

15 WHEREAS, the closing gaps component is intended to set the expectation that all students  
16 and student groups make annual improvements in achievement rates or maintain high levels  
17 of achievement; and

18 WHEREAS, a comprehensive review of the content mastery, progress, and closing gaps  
19 components and the calculations used for such components is needed to ensure that such  
20 components reliably and accurately measure student achievement and progress so that the  
21 CCRPI remains useful for school improvement and accountability and is aligned with the  
22 realities of how students and schools change over time.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

24 (1) **Creation of House study committee.** There is created the House Study Committee  
25 on the College and Career Ready Performance Index (CCRPI).

26 (2) **Members and officers.** The committee shall be composed of six members of the  
27 House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of  
28 Representatives. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate a member  
29 of the committee as chairperson of the committee.

30 (3) **Powers and duties.** The committee shall undertake a study of the conditions, needs,  
31 issues, and problems mentioned above or related thereto and recommend any action or  
32 legislation which the committee deems necessary or appropriate.

33 (4) **Meetings.** The chairperson shall call all meetings of the committee. The committee  
34 may conduct such meetings at such places and at such times as it may deem necessary or  
35 convenient to enable it to exercise fully and effectively its powers, perform its duties, and  
36 accomplish the objectives and purposes of this resolution.

37 (5) **Allowances and funding.** The legislative members of the committee shall receive  
38 the allowances provided for in Code Section 28-1-8 of the Official Code of Georgia  
39 Annotated. The allowances authorized by this resolution shall not be received by any

40 member of the committee for more than five days unless additional days are authorized.  
41 Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this resolution shall come from funds  
42 appropriated to the House of Representatives.

43 **(6) Report.**

44 (A) In the event the committee adopts any specific findings or recommendations that  
45 include suggestions for proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file a report of the  
46 same prior to the date of abolishment specified in this resolution, subject to  
47 subparagraph (C) of this paragraph.

48 (B) In the event the committee adopts a report that does not include suggestions for  
49 proposed legislation, the chairperson shall file the report, subject to subparagraph (C)  
50 of this paragraph.

51 (C) No report shall be filed unless the same has been approved prior to the date of  
52 abolishment specified in this resolution by majority vote of a quorum of the committee.  
53 A report so approved shall be signed by the chairperson of the committee and filed with  
54 the Clerk of the House of Representatives.

55 (D) In the absence of an approved report, the chairperson may file with the Clerk of the  
56 House of Representatives a copy of the minutes of the meetings of the committee in lieu  
57 thereof.

58 **(7) Abolishment.** The committee shall stand abolished on December 1, 2026.
