Senator Seth Harp represents State Senate District 29, which includes parts of Muscogee, Meriwether, Troup, and Harris Counties.

Senator Harp, a Republican, is Chairman of the Higher Education Committee and Vice Chairman of the Judiciary Committee. He is also a member of the Veteran and Military Affairs and Appropriations Committees and is also Ex-Officio of the Insurance and Labor Committee.

A former Captain with the United States Marine Corps and Assistant Staff Judge Advocate with the United States Naval Forces, Senator Harp is an attorney and owner of Harp & Associates. He has also held board positions with many organizations such as the Hospital Authority of Columbus, Kiwanis Club of Columbus, Columbus Symphony Orchestra, Muscogee County School Board and the Better Business Bureau of West Georgia-East Alabama. He is also a member of the NRA, Forest Farmer's Association, Sierra Club, Columbus Chamber of Commerce and the Ida Cason Callaway Foundation.

Senator Harp's additional involvement includes being an author and lecturer. He has been an active supporter of the Republican Party on all levels, most recently having served as a delegate at the 2000 National GOP Convention and as Co-Chair of the State Finance Committee for the 2000 George W. Bush for President campaign.

Born in Monticello, Arkansas, Senator Harp attended Auburn University where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Pharmacy. He also earned his Juris Doctorate from the Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University. Senator Harp is married to Linda Collins Harp of Camilla Georgia and they have two daughters, Mary Rebecca Harp and Leslee Anne Shannon.
