A lifelong resident of Athens and a product of our public schools and the University of Georgia, Senator Brian Kemp works hard every day to serve northeast Georgia.

As a State Senator and member of the Republican Party, Brian Kemp has worked in a bipartisan manner to pass a higher percentage of the legislation he introduced than any other Senator in the 2003-04 sessions, including legislation to protect HOPE, protect water resources and greenspace, and promote early learning efforts. Kemp proudly participated in Habitat for Humanity and served as Committee Chairman of the effort to remodel the Rape Crisis Center which is now the Sexual Assault Center.

Kemp has also served as a Member of the Steering Committee for the Comprehensive Land Use Plan for Athens-Clarke County and the Waste Water Treatment Advisory Committee. Brian Kemp is happily married to the former Marty Argo of Athens. Together, they are the proud parents of Jarrett, Lucy, and Amy Porter. The Kemps are members of Athens Emmanuel Episcopal Church.
