

Senate Resolution 275

ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Designating a portion of U.S. Highway 411 as the Veterans Memorial Highway; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the veterans of Chatsworth, Murray County, and the State of Georgia have
4 faithfully and honorably served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America; and

5 WHEREAS, their dedicated service saved our country from experiencing the ravages of war
6 on the soils of this great nation; and

7 WHEREAS, these brave veterans suffered greatly during the years away from their families
8 and many lost their lives or were wounded; and

9 WHEREAS, they faithfully and honorably persevered until the final victory was won; and

10 WHEREAS, it is most appropriate to honor in perpetuity the sacrifices of these noble and
11 selfless veterans.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 GEORGIA that the portion of U.S. Highway 411 from State Road 286 in Eton, Georgia, to
14 the southernmost city limit sign on U.S. Highway 411 South in Chatsworth, Georgia, is
15 hereby designated as the "Veterans Memorial Highway."

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and
17 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs at appropriate locations designating the
18 highway.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to American Legion Post 167 in Chatsworth,
21 Georgia, and to the commissioner of transportation.
