

Senate Bill 214

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to general provisions regarding the Georgia Lottery, so as to allow a winner of a
3 lottery prize to remain anonymous if he or she donates 25 percent of the prize to the Lottery
4 for Education Account; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 1 of Chapter 27 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 general provisions regarding the Georgia Lottery, is amended by adding a new subsection
10 to Code Section 50-27-25, relating to confidentiality of information obtained by the
11 corporation, to read as follows:

12 "(d) Upon the written request of a prize winner, and a donation of 25 percent of his or her
13 winnings to the Lottery for Education Account, the corporation shall keep all information
14 regarding the winner confidential."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
17 without such approval.

18 **SECTION 3.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
