13 rooted in the communities she serves, tirelessly advancing initiatives that strengthen public
14 safety, infrastructure, and community engagement; and

15 WHEREAS, Gail B. Hambrick is a woman of unassuming greatness whose humble acts of
16 kindness and generosity have uplifted and improved the entire Clayton County community;

18 WHEREAS, Gail B. Hambrick has established a glowing reputation of renown throughout
19 Georgia for her energy, devotion, and commitment to public safety, education, youth
20 services, and recreation in Clayton County; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
22 extraordinary servant leader be appropriately recognized.
