

House Resolution 1144

### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 19, 2026, as Girls Empowerment Day, GlobalHer Justice Day, and the  
2 World Day of Social Justice; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network, founded in July 2016 by Dr. Jacqueline Mohair, an  
4 Outstanding Georgia Citizen Award recipient, has demonstrated a sustained and impactful  
5 commitment to empowering girls and young women through education, leadership  
6 development, violence prevention, and global advocacy; and

7 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network is the founding organization of GlobalHer Justice, an  
8 initiative dedicated to advancing justice, protection, access, and opportunity for women and  
9 girls locally, nationally, and globally, with particular emphasis on survivors of violence,  
10 underserved communities, and systemic equity; and

11 WHEREAS, GlobalHer Justice aligns with the United Nations priority of Justice for Women  
12 and Girls, advancing justice-centered solutions through education, policy awareness,  
13 international dialogue, and collaborative action to strengthen human rights protections and  
14 equitable access to opportunity worldwide; and

15 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network operates as a non-governmental organization with  
16 consultative status under the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC),  
17 enabling advocacy for women and girls on a global platform and alignment with the United  
18 Nations Sustainable Development Goals; and

19 WHEREAS, Trinity Girls Network and GlobalHer Justice extend their impact  
20 internationally, including ongoing humanitarian, educational, and empowerment initiatives  
21 in Zambia and other global regions, providing essential resources, leadership development,  
22 and advocacy support to girls and young women in need; and

23 WHEREAS, despite global progress, millions of girls and young women continue to face  
24 barriers to education, safety, justice, and opportunity, underscoring the urgent need for  
25 coordinated empowerment and justice-centered initiatives; and

26 WHEREAS, research consistently demonstrates that investing in girls and women through  
27 education and justice initiatives leads to healthier families, stronger economies, safer  
28 communities, and lasting generational change; and

29 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is home to countless gifted girls and young women whose  
30 leadership potential is strengthened through initiatives that promote education,  
31 empowerment, civic engagement, and justice; and

32 WHEREAS, the observance of Girls Empowerment Day and GlobalHer Justice Day on  
33 February 19, 2026, intentionally aligns with the United Nations World Day of Social Justice,  
34 reinforcing a shared commitment to justice-centered solutions that empower girls and  
35 women, address systemic inequities, and promote dignity, safety, and opportunity at the  
36 local, national, and global levels; and

37 WHEREAS, the annual observance of Girls Empowerment Day, GlobalHer Justice Day, and  
38 the World Day of Social Justice convenes Trinity Girls Network, GlobalHer Justice, The Dr.  
39 Pat Houston Performing Arts Academy, The Organization of World Leaders, and The  
40 Whitney Houston Foundation at the Georgia State Capitol to elevate awareness, inspire  
41 leadership, and advance justice for women and girls.

42 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
43 the members of this body commend Trinity Girls Network and the GlobalHer Justice  
44 initiative for their leadership, service, and advocacy on behalf of women and girls in Georgia  
45 and around the world, including their work in partnership with the United Nations.

46 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of this body recognize February 19, 2026,  
47 as Girls Empowerment Day, GlobalHer Justice Day, and the World Day of Social Justice,  
48 honoring the achievements, resilience, and promise of girls and young women while  
49 affirming justice, education, equity, and opportunity as foundational pillars of empowerment.

50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
51 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
52 public and the press.
