A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing February 10, 2026, as Interfaith Children’s Movement Day at the capitol; and
2 for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, founded on September 11, 2001, Interfaith Children’s Movement (ICM) is a
4 Georgia-based policy and advocacy organization dedicated to advancing child-centered
5 public policy and strengthening systems that support children, families, and communities;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, rooted in faith values and guided by principles of equity, justice, and human
8 dignity, ICM works to ensure that all children in Georgia-regardless of income, race,
9 geography, or background-have access to opportunity, stability, and wellbeing; and

10 WHEREAS, ICM engages in legislative advocacy, policy analysis, coalition-building, and
11 civic engagement to address structural barriers impacting children and families; its policy
12 priorities include education equity, child welfare and protection, maternal and infant health,
13 health access, economic security, food security, and community stability; and

14 WHEREAS, through strategic partnerships with faith communities, nonprofit organizations,
15 and public institutions, ICM advances preventative, evidence-based, and

16 community-informed solutions that strengthen Georgia's public systems and promote
17 long-term social and economic mobility; and

18 WHEREAS, Interfaith Children's Movement serves as a trusted voice for children and
19 families in Georgia, working to shape policy that reflects shared values, responsible
20 governance, and a commitment to the common good.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
22 recognize February 10, 2026, as Interfaith Children's Movement Day at the capitol.

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
24 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to Interfaith
25 Children's Movement.
