- 2 WHEREAS, Dr. Anissa D. Hunter is a United States Navy veteran, author, educator, and
3 mental health advocate; and
- 4 WHEREAS, she honorably served in the United States Navy as a Personnelman and
5 Legalman, valiantly and courageously protecting her fellow Americans aboard the USS
6 Yosemite (AD-71) and USS Eisenhower (CVN-69); and
- 7 WHEREAS, following her military service, Dr. Hunter has dedicated her career to advocacy,
8 education, and leadership development, particularly in the areas of mental health awareness,
9 holistic wellness, and community support; and
- 10 WHEREAS, she is the author of *Baby Steps to Holistic Living* and the forthcoming
11 *Whole-Powered Leadership*, which is grounded in her proprietary clarity-driven,
12 human-centered leadership framework that integrates evidence-based leadership principles,
13 whole-person sustainability, and real-world application to support alignment, accountability,
