## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the lives of Howell and Jane Teasley and dedicating an intersection in their  
2 memory; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Howell and Jane Teasley have long been recognized by the citizens of this state  
4 for the vital role that they played in leadership and their deep personal commitment to the  
5 welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Howell Teasley grew up in Elberton, Georgia, and earned a bachelor's  
7 degree in accounting from the University of Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Teasley diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his  
9 time, talents, and energy for 35 years to the contracts department at Lockheed Martin; and

10 WHEREAS, Jane Teasley grew up in Franklin, North Carolina, and dedicated her time to the  
11 field of education at schools such as Awtry Middle School in Acworth, Georgia, and Shiloh  
12 Hills Christian School in Kennesaw, Georgia; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Teasley demonstrated their deep and abiding faith as active  
14 members of Morganton Baptist Church, where they helped found Mountain Area Christian  
15 Academy; and

16 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these remarkable and distinguished  
17 Georgians be appropriately recognized by dedicating an intersection in their memory.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE GENERAL  
19 ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA that the intersection of State Route 515 and the Hemptown  
20 Connector in Fannin County is dedicated as the Howell and Jane Teasley Memorial  
21 Intersection.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
23 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs dedicating the Howell and Jane Teasley  
24 Memorial Intersection.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
26 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
27 family of Howell and Jane Teasley and to the Department of Transportation.
