## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Major William "Rusty" Furman Jr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia lost one of its finest citizens and most dedicated law  
3 enforcement officers with the passing of Major William "Rusty" Furman Jr. on February 22,  
4 2026; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Major William "Rusty" Furman Jr. was an original member of the Dunwoody  
6 Police Department who dedicated 28 years of service in law enforcement, including roles  
7 within the Marietta and Cobb County police departments; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was highly regarded by the citizens of his community and state and by local  
9 government officials as a person of unquestioned integrity and dedication to the sound  
10 principles of law enforcement; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Major William "Rusty" Furman Jr. exhibited extraordinary devotion to public  
12 service, outstanding loyalty, fine leadership, and meticulous attention to detail in all of his  
13 duties; and

14 WHEREAS, he will long be remembered for his inspiring commitment to the welfare of  
15 others, which stands as a shining example of the positive effect law enforcement  
16 professionals have on the lives and well-being of others.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
18 the members of this body join in honoring the life and memory of Major William "Rusty"  
19 Furman Jr. and express their most sincere condolences at his passing.
