A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring Terri Brown for her exceptional service and dedication to the citizens of Georgia;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Terri Brown has demonstrated an unwavering commitment to serving others
4 as a Medical, Financial, and Legal Liaison, dedicating her career to bridging critical gaps
5 between hospitals, courtrooms, and the clients she serves; and

6 WHEREAS, through her work, she has provided invaluable assistance to individuals in need
7 by helping them navigate doctor's appointments, financial challenges, and legal matters,
8 ensuring that they receive comprehensive and compassionate support during times of need;

10 WHEREAS, she has served as an external case manager, coordinating follow-up care,
11 organizing in-home services, and ensuring the continued care and safety of her clients as
12 intended by medical professionals; and

13 WHEREAS, prior to her civilian service, Terri Brown honorably served her country for 20
14 years as a United States Army Medic/EMT, during which time she performed a wide range
15 of critical duties, including serving as an Emergency Room Technician and supporting

16 specialized areas such as OB/GYN, thoracic surgery, plastic surgery, and neurosurgery at
17 Landstuhl Regional Medical Center and Fort Benning; and

18 WHEREAS, during her distinguished military career, she also contributed her expertise to
19 the Army Substance Abuse and Suicide Prevention Office, further demonstrating her
20 dedication to the health and well-being of others; and

21 WHEREAS, she has utilized the knowledge and experience gained throughout her military
22 service to help individuals better understand medical instructions and ensure proper
23 continuation of care in the home; and

24 WHEREAS, Terri Brown is a woman of notable academic achievement, having earned an
25 associate's degree in business administration from Georgia Military College, a bachelor's
26 degree in business finance from Columbus State University, and a paralegal certificate from
27 Auburn University; and

28 WHEREAS, she has applied her education and skills to assist individuals in navigating
29 complex financial and legal systems, empowering them with the tools and understanding
30 necessary to improve their lives; and

31 WHEREAS, her spirit of service extends beyond her professional career, as she continues
32 to support both youth and senior citizens through fostering and adoption as well as serving
33 as the legal guardian of a 96-year-old individual in need of guidance and care, ensuring
34 dignity, stability, and quality of life; and

35 WHEREAS, her tireless efforts to bridge gaps within the community have helped seniors
36 enjoy their later years with dignity and have provided youth with stronger foundations for
37 success; and

38 WHEREAS, Terri Brown's life's work embodies compassion, leadership, and a steadfast
