

SENATOR STEVEN MCNEEL

GEORGIA'S 18TH SENATE DISTRICT

Senator Steven McNeel, a Republican, was elected to serve in the Georgia State Senate in a special election in 2026. He represents Senate District 18, which includes all of Monroe, Crawford, Upson and Peach counties, as well as portions of Houston and Macon-Bibb Counties. He serves as a member of the Senate Committees on Banking and Financial Institutions, Education and Youth, Natural Resources and the Environment, State and Local Governmental Operations, Transportation and Judiciary.

Sen. McNeel was born and raised in Georgia. He is a graduate of the University of Georgia, where Sen. McNeel earned his B.A. in Political Science and met his wife of 20 years, Mollie. He then attended Mercer University's Walter F. Georgia School of Law, where he obtained his J.D. He practices law at Buzzell, Welsh & Hill in Macon, Georgia, focusing on representing injured persons and their families.

A lifelong Republican, Sen. McNeel has volunteered and worked on numerous local, statewide and federal Republican campaigns.

He is a member of Tall Timbers, the Georgia Trial Lawyers Association, Longleaf Alliance, the Georgia-Alabama Land Trust, Georgia Forestry Association, and Georgia Agribusiness Council. In his free time, Sen. McNeel enjoys working on his family's timber farm in southwest Georgia.
