

## <u>Biography</u>

State Representative Matt Reeves represents Suwanee, Sugar Hill and Duluth in Georgia State House District 99.

Rep. Reeves serves as a member of the House Majority Caucus Whip Team and as the vice chairman of the House Judiciary Committee and as Secretary of the Reapportionment and Redistricting Committee. He also serves on the Appropriations, Appropriations Subcommittee on General Government and Insurance committees.
