District 34**

Biography

Representative Devan Seabaugh was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives in a special election in July 2021. He represents House District 34, which includes west Cobb County and portions of the cities of Marietta and Kennesaw.

Rep. Seabaugh serves on several key House legislative committees, including Appropriations, Transportation, Industry & Labor, Community & Public Health, Creative Arts & Entertainment and Energy, Utilities & Telecommunications.

In addition to his committee service, Rep. Seabaugh holds multiple leadership positions within the House. He serves as vice chairman of the House Industry & Labor Committee, vice chairman of the Appropriations Subcommittee on Health and vice chairman of the Creative Arts & Entertainment Committee. He has served as a Deputy Whip for the Republican Majority House caucus and currently serves as a Governor's Floor Leader.

Representative Seabaugh brings more than four decades of leadership in healthcare and emergency medicine to his work under the Gold Dome. A career paramedic and currently a healthcare executive with Metro Atlanta Ambulance Service, he has dedicated his professional life to protecting lives, strengthening emergency response systems, and improving access to quality healthcare. His experience on the front lines of emergency services continues to shape his practical, result-driven approach to public policy.

Representative Seabaugh is widely recognized for his leadership and unwavering commitment to public safety and the men and women who serve on the front lines. Drawing on his lifelong career in emergency services, he has championed policies that support the mental wellbeing of first responders, improve emergency medical and trauma care systems, and ensure communities have the resources needed to respond quickly and effectively in times of crisis. He believes that safe communities are the foundation for strong families and thriving local economies.

He is equally committed to strengthening education and supporting educators, recognizing that student success begins with well-prepared teachers, safe schools, and strong partnerships with parents. Representative Seabaugh has worked to advance school safety, school nursing, early literacy, expand educational opportunities and ensure our public schools are fully funded and that

educators have the tools and resources needed to help every child succeed. He has also supported Georgia's Charter School and Private School systems giving Georgia's children every opportunity to succeed.

Representative Seabaugh has also been a strong advocate of children living in Georgia's Foster Care system as well as individuals with developmental disabilities and mental health needs, including those living with autism and other special needs. He has supported and worked on legislation aimed at expanding access to services, improving care coordination, and ensuring families have the resources and support necessary to help their loved ones live safe, healthy and productive lives. His work reflects a belief that public policy should promote dignity, opportunity, and compassion for every individual and every family.

In addition, Representative Seabaugh has been a leading voice in protecting personal property rights while also safeguarding Georgia's social safety net programs, ensuring they remain funded and available to those who truly need them. He has worked on legislation and community initiatives focused on affordable housing, housing stability for veterans and responsible solutions to support individuals experiencing homelessness. His approach emphasizes both accountability and compassion protecting homeowners and property owners while preserving pathways to stable housing and support services for vulnerable populations.

Understanding the real pressures facing working families, Representative Seabaugh also prioritizes policies that promote affordable childcare and family stability. He believes that access to safe, reliable childcare is essential for parents to remain in the workforce, support their households and build a secure future for their children. His legislative work reflects a holistic view of public service—one that supports not only individual programs, but the overall wellbeing of the entire family.

Beyond the Capitol, Representative Seabaugh remains actively involved in the local community. He has provided leadership to numerous nonprofit and community organizations dedicated to advancing the performing arts, strengthening healthcare, supporting youth development, enhancing public safety and serving families in need. His service reflects a lifelong commitment to giving back and building stronger, more resilient communities across Georgia.

He currently serves on the boards of the Metro Atlanta EMS Academy, the Cobb Chamber of Commerce, the Earl Smith Strand Theatre and WellStar Kennestone Regional Medical Center. He is a previous board member for MUST Ministries, Cobb Safety Village, the Boys & Girls Club, the Metro Atlanta YMCA, Safe Kids Georgia and the Boy Scouts of America.

His faith, family and decades of service continue to guide his work in the General Assembly, where he remains focused on protecting families, supporting first responders and educators, strengthening communities, and building a safer, more secure future for all Georgians.
