HOUSE BILLS

<u>HB 15</u>	Banking and finance; update terminology; provisions
<u>HB 36</u>	Guardian and ward; revise list of providers who are authorized to participate in the processes for appointment of a guardian for an adult
<u>HB 38</u>	Education; needs based financial aid program; revise definition of eligible student
<u>HB 55</u>	Alapaha Judicial Circuit; superior court; provide for an additional judge
<u>HB 61</u>	Motor vehicles; issuance of separate license plates for hearses and ambulances; provide
<u>HB 73</u>	Seminole County; Board of Education; provide nonpartisan elections
<u>HB 77</u>	Motor vehicles; encountering funeral procession on two-lane highway; revise responsibilities
<u>HB 89</u>	Public Health, Department of; require healthcare providers, facilities, and pharmacies to provide the Maternal Mortality Review Committee with psychiatric or other clinical records
<u>HB 92</u>	Revenue and taxation; postpone date by which local governing authorities can opt out of base year homestead exemption
<u>HB 94</u>	Insurance; medically necessary expenses for standard fertility preservation services when a medically necessary treatment for cancer, sickle cell disease, or lupus may directly or indirectly cause an impairment of fertility; require coverage
<u>HB 107</u>	Professions and businesses; issuance of digitally verifiable licenses for certain military spouses and transitioning military service members; provide
<u>HB 110</u>	Pawnbrokers; certain protections for current military members and related persons; provide
<u>HB 114</u>	Motor vehicles; federal regulations regarding safe operation of commercial motor vehicle and carriers; update reference date
<u>HB 116</u>	Public Safety, Department of; Motor Carrier Compliance Division to Commercial Vehicle Enforcement; change name
<u>HB 124</u>	Insurance; require coverage for healthcare services for pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders; provisions
<u>HB 131</u>	Self-service storage facilities; revise advertisement requirements before an owner can enforce an owner's lien
<u>HB 137</u>	Contracts; increase dollar value of certain public works contracts exempt from provisions relating to retention of contractual payments
<u>HB 147</u>	Georgia Technology Authority; annual inventory of artificial intelligence usage by state agencies; provide

<u>HB 155</u>	Local government; selection and objection to arbitrators; revise procedures
<u>HB 180</u>	Probate courts; modify certain requirements for probate judges
<u>HB 182</u>	Life insurance; excluding or restricting liability for certain deaths occurring while an individual is an active duty service member; prohibit
<u>HB 199</u>	Courts; protection of personally identifiable information of judges and their spouses; modify provisions
<u>HB 208</u>	Special license plates; support state parks and historic sites; establish
