

LOCAL LEGISLATION CALENDAR GEORGIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Saturday, June 20, 2026

PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION II, PARAGRAPH IV OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION, THE FOLLOWING LOCAL BILLS RELATING TO HOMESTEAD EXEMPTIONS REQUIRE A TWO-THIRDS ROLL-CALL VOTE FOR PASSAGE:
