- SB 553** Professions and Businesses; repeal Chapter 14, relating to electrical contractors, plumbers, conditioned air contractors, low voltage contractors, and utility contractors and enact a new Chapter 14 (**Substitute**) (RI&U-50th)
- SB 410** State Sales and Use Taxes; the data center equipment sales and use tax exemption; repeal (**Substitute**) (FIN-6th)
- SB 542** Sexual Offenses; clergy members to be charged with certain improper sexual contact offenses; permit (**Substitute**) (Amendment) (JUDY-29th)
- SB 442** Drivers' Licenses; revocation and expiration of commercial drivers' licenses for noncitizens; provide (**Substitute**) (PUB SAF-21st)
- SB 445** "Georgia Promise Scholarship Act"; public schools with a state-wide attendance zone and certain charter schools shall not be included in the separate list of public schools annually reported by the Office of Student Achievement; provide (**Substitute**) (ED&Y-27th)
- SB 555** War Veterans Home; the admission of eligible nonveteran residents to a Georgia War Veterans' Home under certain circumstances; authorize (VM&HS-25th)
- SB 566** Ad Valorem Taxation of Property; the acceptance of tax digests in the event of a publication error made by a newspaper; provide (**Substitute**) (FIN-52nd)
- SB 423** Government Transparency; campaign committees, independent committees, political action committees, and leadership committees from accepting contributions or donations from non-Georgia persons that exceed 50 percent of all contributions received; prohibit (**Substitute**) (ETHICS-30th)

- SB 572 Criminal Prosecutions; an additional justification for use of force in defense of self or others; provide (JUDY-42nd)
- SB 439 "Fair Business Practices Act of 1975"; regulation of referral agencies for assisted living communities and personal care homes; provide (Substitute) (Amendment) (H&HS-48th)
- SR 838 "State Assurance of Voter Eligibility (SAVE) Amendment" -CA (ETHICS-27th)
- SB 573 Primaries and Elections; the nonpartisan election for county officers and district attorneys in certain counties; provide (ETHICS-37th)
- SB 587 Offenses Against Public Health and Morals; the establishment of an animal cruelty database; provide (PUB SAF-48th)
- SB 589 "Quality Basic Education Act"; the date by which a child must attain a certain age to be eligible for enrollment in kindergarten or first grade; revise (Substitute) (ED&Y-6th)
- SB 301 State Flag, Seal, and Other Symbols; protection of government statues, monuments, plaques, banners, and other commemorative symbols; revise provisions (Substitute) (SLGO(G)-25th)
- SB 605 Prosecuting Attorneys; additional grounds for discipline of a district attorney or solicitor-general or for his or her removal or involuntary retirement from office; provide (Substitute) (INVEST-46th)
- SB 515 "Quality Basic Education Act"; grants for educational programs; provisions relative to the teacher recruitment and retention tax credit program; revise (Substitute) (FIN-4th)
- SB 594 Internet and E-mail Fraud; the criminal offense of digital identity fraud; establish (JUDY-30th)
- SB 540 Online Internet Safety; certain disclosures related to conversational AI services; require (Substitute) (C&F-31st)
- SB 454 Regulation of Fire and Other Hazards; use of temporary door locking devices in public buildings during certain emergency situations; authorize (PUB SAF-25th)

- SB 458 "Home Inspector Licensing Act of Georgia"; enact (Substitute) (RI&U-8th)
- SB 465 Income Taxes; business enterprises that hire illegal aliens for large-scale projects from claiming certain tax credits associated with such projects; disqualify (Substitute) (FIN-51st)
- SB 482 Law Enforcement Officers and Agencies; persons requesting booking photographs to provide the first and last names of the individuals in the photographs; require (Substitute) (PUB SAF-42nd)
- SB 485 Professional Counselors; applicants for a license in social work enrolled in a master's degree program to take the master's social work licensing examination in their final semester of the program; authorize (RI&U-54th)
- SB 498 Georgia Charter School Facilities Authority; establish (Substitute) (FIN-45th)
- SB 501 Office of the Safety Fire Commissioner; update provisions (Substitute) (PUB SAF-29th)
- SB 551 Standard, Labeling, and Adulteration of Food; eggs; repeal provisions (AG&CA-11th)
- SB 547 Offenses of Pimping and Pandering; modify the penalties (JUDY-42nd)
- SB 591 Offenses Against Public Order; the disruption of a religious service; prohibit (JUDY-51st)
- SB 593 Development Impact Fees; disclosure of impact fees upon transfer of ownership; provide (Substitute) (SLGO(G)-50th)
- SB 278 Standards, Labeling, and Adulteration of Food; corn masa flour and wet corn masa products to contain certain amounts of folic acid; require (Substitute) (AG&CA-40th)
- SB 324 Life Insurance; certain protections for life insurance policyholders and beneficiaries; provide (Substitute) (I&L-16th)


- SB 367 Certificate of Need; health care facilities, services, and equipment dedicated exclusively to the treatment of cancer; provide for exemption (Substitute) (RI&U-46th)
- SB 418 Torts; cause of action against the knowing and unauthorized use of an individual's photograph or image together with representations of nudity or sexually explicit conduct; provide (Substitute) (JUDY-23rd)
- SB 488 Torts; generative artificial intelligence systems shall constitute personal property for purposes of certain actions for product liability alleging injury to a minor; provide (JUDY-37th)
- SB 499 Dangerous Instrumentalities and Practices; prohibition on possessing a silencer; repeal (Substitute) (JUDY-47th)
- SB 556 HOPE Scholarship; the inclusion of advanced placement and international baccalaureate fine arts courses in the calculation of grade point averages; provide (Substitute) (H ED-54th)
- SB 569 Motor Vehicles and Traffic; the issuance of emergency vehicle light permits for towing service companies in certain instances; provide (PUB SAF-42nd)
- SB 570 "Georgia Human Trafficking Prevention Training Act"; enact (Substitute) (PUB SAF-48th)
- SB 586 "K-9 Law Enforcement Heroes Act of 2026"; enact (PUB SAF-25th)
- SB 592 "One Strike Act"; enact (JUDY-51st)
- SB 604 Crimes and Offenses; the Attorney General concurrent jurisdiction with district attorneys to conduct criminal prosecutions of violent crimes, illegal immigration offenses, and fentanyl offenses; provide (Substitute) (INVEST-46th)
- SB 606 "District Attorney Compensation Reform Act"; enact (Substitute) (INVEST-46th)
- SB 607 Grand Juries; creation, selection, composition, compensation, procedures, and term; provide (Substitute) (INVEST-46th)

- SR 875 State-Wide Grand Juries; jurisdiction, powers, and duties; provide -CA (INVEST-46th)
- SR 262 Article V of the United States Constitution; a convention of the states; apply (JUDY-46th)
- SB 405 Magistrate Court; the maximum amount of civil claims that can be tried in magistrate court; increase (JUDY-37th)
- SB 11 Retirement; creditable service for certain military service; provide (RET-33rd)
- SB 190 Parks, Historic Areas, Memorials, and Recreation; certain fee waivers for active duty members of the military, veterans, and family members; provide (Substitute) (VM&HS-34th)
- SB 202 Discovery; discovery in misdemeanor cases; change provisions (JUDY-22nd)
- SB 209 Teachers Retirement System of Georgia; members of the Public School Employees Retirement System to make an irrevocable election to become members; permit certain persons (Substitute) (RET-8th)
- SB 327 Clayton Judicial Circuit; sixth judge of the superior courts; provide (Substitute) (JUDY-44th)
- SB 475 Charter School Funding; local boards of education to treat local charter schools no less favorably than other local schools; expenditure of the proceeds of a special purpose local option sales tax; require (Substitute) (ED&Y-38th)
- SB 532 Proceedings; defendant notices of certain proceedings and pleadings when such defendant failed to file pleadings; provide (JUDY-39th)
- SB 568 Elections and Primaries; the list of eligible voters is posted and made public prior to each primary or election; require (Substitute) (ETHICS-27th)
- SB 473 Motor Vehicles and Traffic; submission of proof of completion of certified DUI Alcohol or Drug Use Risk Reduction Programs by certain applicants to obtain limited driving permits; require (Substitute) (PUB SAF-29th)
