The Georgia State Senate Press Office is currently looking to fill two (2) Communications Aide positions for the 2022 Legislative Session of the Georgia General Assembly. This is a **temporary, full-time paid position** that will run for the duration of the 2022 Legislative Session, projected to run from January to the beginning of April. Responsibilities of the Senate Press Office Aides include:

- Compiling daily news clips
- Drafting press releases, speeches, scripts and Op-Eds
- Monitoring Senate Chamber session days to accurately record bill summaries and vote counts
- Writing and editing a “Week in Review” document for Senators and legislative staff
- Maintaining and updating media lists and Senator bios
- Assisting with press conferences
- Answering and directing phone calls (screen, take messages, transfer calls for staff)
- Identifying and brainstorming communications strategies with SPO staff
- Attending and recording committee meetings when necessary for SPO staff
- Monitoring social media and news as it relates to the Georgia Senate
- Providing research support on a wide range of issues as needed

Candidates must have strong written communication skills, knowledge of communication strategy, AP Style and familiarity with social media plans. Preference will be given to candidates who have graduated with or are pursuing a degree in Public Relations, Communications, Political Science or a related field.
