

House Bill 321 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act establishing a charter for the City of Fairburn, approved August 3, 1925
2 (Ga. L. 1925, p. 1024), as amended, so as to remove the millage caps on ad valorem taxation
3 of real and personal property; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 An Act establishing a charter for the City of Fairburn, approved August 3, 1925 (Ga. L.
7 1925, p. 1024), as amended, is amended by revising Section 30 as follows:

8 "SECTION 30.

9 The mayor and council of the City of Fairburn are hereby authorized to prescribe by
10 ordinance for the assessment, levy, and collection of an ad valorem tax on all real and
11 personal property within the corporate limits of said city for the following purposes:

- 12 (1) General purposes, including operation of city government;
13 (2) Maintenance of streets and sidewalks;
14 (3) General improvements in the City of Fairburn; and
15 (4) Such rate as is necessary to meet the annual interest on outstanding bonds against
16 said city and such amount as the mayor and council may deem necessary as a sinking
17 fund to retire outstanding bonds against said city."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
