

**LOST**

Senators Williams of the 19th and Loudermilk of the 14th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 354 (LC 33 5118S) by adding after the semicolon on line 100 the following:*

2 provided, however, that no department, official, or employee of the executive branch may  
3 commit to participation in a federal education program unless the department, official,  
4 or employee first informs the General Assembly about the federal program and provides  
5 a full analysis of the following:

6 (A) The long-term projections of unfunded costs for both state and local governments,  
7 which projections shall cover at least 12 years;

8 (B) Any resulting transfer of governing control of any aspect of education from state  
9 or local officials to any other entity outside the state, whether in the federal government  
10 or elsewhere;

11 (C) The purpose and effect of the federal program, including its effect on and  
12 interrelationship with any existing program currently operating within the state; and

13 (D) Any negative effects on the constitutional rights of Georgia citizens to exercise  
14 control over education;
