

House Bill 592 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act establishing the State Court of Pierce County, approved August 15, 1911
2 (Ga. L. 1911, p. 210), as amended, so as to change the compensation of the judge and
3 solicitor-general of the state court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws;
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act establishing the State Court of Pierce County, approved August 15, 1911 (Ga. L.
8 1911, p. 210), as amended, is amended by striking Section 2A in its entirety and inserting in
9 lieu thereof a new Section 2A to read as follows:

10 "SECTION 2A.

11 (a) The judge of the State Court of Pierce County shall receive an annual base salary of
12 \$40,084.02 which shall be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Pierce
13 County.

14 (b) On and after the effective date of this Act, when all other county officers receive a
15 cost-of-living increase in salary, the base salary of the judge of the State Court of Pierce
16 County provided in subsection (a) of this section plus any increases which have been
17 received by the judge under this subsection shall be increased by the same amount or
18 percentage as the increase received by such other county officers."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 Said Act is further amended by striking Section 4A in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof
21 a new Section 4A to read as follows:

22 "SECTION 4A.

23 (a) The solicitor-general of the State Court of Pierce County shall receive an annual base
24 salary of \$38,117.80 which shall be paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of
25 Pierce County.

26 (b) On and after the effective date of this Act, when all other county officers receive a
27 cost-of-living increase in salary, the base salary of the solicitor-general of the State Court
28 of Pierce County provided in subsection (a) of this section plus any increases which have
29 been received by the solicitor-general under this subsection shall be increased by the same
30 amount or percentage as the increase received by such other county officers."

31 **SECTION 3.**

32 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
33 without such approval.

34 **SECTION 4.**

35 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
