A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta therapy dogs known as
2 "Canines For Kids"; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Canines For Kids Program was established
4 in 2009; and

5 WHEREAS, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta employs 13 full-time therapy dogs in various
6 departments at Egleston and Scottish Rite as well as the Marcus Autism Center; and

7 WHEREAS, therapy dogs undergo a comprehensive and intensive training process for a
8 duration of 18 months; and

9 WHEREAS, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Canines For Kids have had a positive impact
10 on the emotional well-being and physical health of patients; and

11 WHEREAS, hospital therapy dogs have calmed fears, provided comfort, and reduced anxiety
12 for children and their families; and

13 WHEREAS, therapy dogs undertake a wide range of tasks in clinical settings including but
14 not limited to easing patient fears prior to surgery, motivating children who undergo
15 rehabilitation, and distracting children from painful treatment; and

16 WHEREAS, the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Canines For Kids Program has been
17 recognized nationally for its success, and other children's hospitals across the country are
18 seeking to replicate the program; and

19 WHEREAS, Children's Healthcare of Atlanta is a nation-wide leader and model for the
20 holistic treatment and care of pediatric patients by focusing on the emotional, physical,
21 mental, and spiritual needs.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
23 recognize and commend the Children's Healthcare of Atlanta therapy dogs known as
24 "Canines For Kids."
