A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the special friendship between Georgia and the People's Republic of China and
2 recognizing February 3, 2020, as China Day at the state capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, there is a bond of friendship between the citizens of Georgia and China, and the
4 people of Georgia welcome opportunities to grow our already deep relationship at all levels
5 including cultural, academic, and business; and

6 WHEREAS, the year 2020 ushers in Lunar Year 4718, the Year of the Rat, and begins a new
7 12 year cycle in the traditional Chinese calendar; and

8 WHEREAS, the National Association of Chinese Americans (NACA) celebrated their 40
9 year anniversary recently; and

10 WHEREAS, the NACA has consistently played an important role in harmonizing
11 China-United States relationships both locally in Atlanta as well as nationally through its
12 excellent relationship and connection with the Embassy of China in Washington D.C. and
13 the Consulate General of China in Houston, Texas; the NACA has been working with the
14 Consulate General of China in Houston since 2019.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend the special friendship between Georgia and the People's Republic of China,
17 recognize the Consul General Cai Wei of the Consulate General of China in Houston, and
18 recognize February 3, 2020, as China Day at the state capitol.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the public and the
21 press.
