A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alcoholic beverages,
2 so as to change the maximum amount of distilled spirits a manufacturer can sell for
3 consumption off the premises per consumer per day; to provide for related matters; to repeal
4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to alcoholic beverages, is
8 amended by revising subsection (a) of Code Section 3-4-24.2, relating to the three-tier
9 system of distribution and sale of distilled spirits, Sunday sales, regulatory authority, and
10 conditions or limitations, as follows:

11 "(a) A limited exception to the provisions of this title providing a three-tier system for the
12 distribution and sale of distilled spirits shall exist to the extent that the license to
13 manufacture distilled spirits in this state shall include the right to sell up to 500 barrels of
14 distilled spirits per year produced at the distiller's licensed premises to individuals who are
15 on such premises for:

16 (1) Consumption on the premises; and

17 (2) Consumption off the premises, provided that such sales for consumption off the
18 premises shall not exceed a maximum of ~~2,250~~ 4,500 milliliters of distilled spirits per
19 consumer per day."

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
