

The House Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security offers the following substitute to HB 859:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 tinting of windows or windshields, so as to provide for a maximum monetary penalty; to
3 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 **SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 40-8-73.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to tinting of
7 windows or windshields, is amended by revising subsection (h) as follows:

8 "(h) Any person who violates subsection (b) or (e) of this Code section shall be guilty of
9 a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$25.00, but the provisions of
10 Chapter 11 of Title 17 and any other provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
11 costs of such prosecution shall not be taxed nor shall any additional penalty, fee, or
12 surcharge to a fine for such offense be assessed against a person for conviction thereof."

13 **SECTION 2.**

14 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
