A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend an Act providing for the election of members of the board of education of Baldwin County, approved April 3, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3325), as amended, particularly by an Act approved April 13, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 6143), so as to revise the compensation of the members of such board; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 8 An Act providing for the election of members of the board of education of Baldwin County, 9 approved April 3, 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3325), as amended, particularly by an Act approved 10 April 13, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 6143), is amended by revising subsection (a) of Section 5 as 11 follows: 12 "SECTION 5. 13 (a) Members of the Baldwin County Board of Education shall receive pay up to \$500.00 14 per month for each month or portion of a month during which they serve on the board of 15 education. In addition, the members of the board shall be reimbursed for actual expenses

16 necessarily incurred in connection with attendance at meetings of the board and while

17 traveling within or outside the state as a member or a committee of the board on official 18 business first authorized by a majority of the members of the board. The accounts for such 19 expenses shall be submitted for approval to the county school superintendent. The 20 compensation of members of the board shall be paid only from the local tax funds available 21 to the board for education purposes and shall be paid only if the board appropriates money 22 to pay the members such salaries. In the event that the board does not appropriate money 23 to pay such salaries, the board members shall be paid whatever lesser amount is approved 24 and appropriated by majority vote of the board." 25 **SECTION 2.**

This Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the month in which such Act is approved by the Governor or in which it becomes law without such approval.

- 29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
