A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 elections and primaries generally, so as to limit the distribution of absentee ballot
- 3 applications to certain election officials and candidates; to provide for certain disclosures;
- 4 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elections and
- 8 primaries generally, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Code Section 21-2-381, relating
- 9 to making of application for absentee ballot, determination of eligibility by ballot clerk,
- 10 furnishing of applications to colleges and universities, and persons entitled to make
- 11 application, as follows:
- 12 "(c)(1) No person, other than the Secretary of State, an election superintendent, a board
- of registrars, or a candidate or a candidate's campaign committee shall distribute forms
- or applications for obtaining an absentee ballot in this state. Each such form or
- application shall have printed on it in prominent type the name of the election official,

candidate, or candidate's campaign committee that is responsible for the printing and distribution of such forms or applications.

(2) In those counties or municipalities in which the absentee ballot clerk or board of registrars provides application forms for absentee ballots, the clerk or board shall provide such quantity of the application form to the dean of each college or university located in that county as said dean determines necessary for the students of such college or university."

23 SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
