A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending the Centennial Celebration in Twin City, Georgia; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Twin City, Georgia, is celebrating 100 years since its creation; and

4 WHEREAS, Twin City is planning a year-long Centennial Celebration; and

5 WHEREAS, in 1921, B. Lewis Brinson introduced a legislative Act to incorporate the cities
6 of Graymont and Summit to form Twin City; and

7 WHEREAS, Twin City was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 2014; and

8 WHEREAS, until 2014, Twin City was the only town in Georgia formed by merging two
9 existing towns; and

10 WHEREAS, Twin City is a city of distinction due to its architecture, commerce, and
11 community planning and development.

12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
13 recognize and commend the Centennial Celebration in Twin City, Georgia.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
