A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled substance or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, so as to change the date of incorporation of local ordinances by reference; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

SECTION 1.

8 Code Section 16-13-32.6 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 9 manufacturing, distributing, dispensing, or possessing with intent to distribute controlled 10 substance or marijuana in, on, or within drug-free commercial zones, is amended by revising 11 subsection (f) as follows:

12 "(f) The General Assembly hereby adopts and incorporates into this Code section all 13 drug-free commercial zones which have been adopted by municipal or county ordinance 14 and entered in the register of the Department of Community Affairs as provided for in 15 subsection (d) of this Code section on or before July 1, 2015 2021."
