- 11 (B) This Such term does shall not include:
- 12 (i) merely Merely placing raw or dried material into another container or packaging
- raw or dried material for resale; or
- 14 (ii) Traditional farming practices such as those commonly known as drying, shucking
- and bucking, storing, trimming, and curing."
