6 four years old and has a profound connection with the immigrant community; and

9 as the founder of the first nonprofit law center dedicated to Asian immigrants and refugees

13 all people is an additional testament to her commitment to those in need; and

18 unyielding commitment to her fellow citizens have set the standard for civic service; and

19 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments and
20 contributions of this remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

22 the members of this body recognize and commend Helen Ho for her efficient, effective,
23 unselfish, and dedicated service to the State of Georgia and extend the most sincere best
