AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for the composition of the Board of Education of Evans County,
2 approved March 26, 1987 (Ga. L. 1987, p. 4782), as amended, so as to revise the
3 compensation of the board; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
4 other purposes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act providing for the composition of the Board of Education of Evans County, approved
8 March 26, 1987 (Ga. L. 1987, p. 4782), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (b)
9 of Section 5 as follows:

10 "(b)(1) The chairperson of the board shall be compensated in the amount of \$400.00 for
11 each day of attendance at meetings of the board and while meeting and traveling within
12 or outside the state as a member of a committee of the board on official business
13 preapproved by a majority of the board, provided that such compensation shall not
14 exceed \$800.00 per month.

15 (2) Each member of the board other than the chairperson shall be compensated in the
16 amount of \$200.00 for each day of attendance at meetings of the board and while meeting

and traveling within or outside the state as a member of a committee of the board on official business preapproved by a majority of the board, provided that such compensation shall not exceed \$400.00 per month.

(3) In addition to the compensation provided for in paragraphs (1) and (2) of this subsection, the chairperson and each member of the board shall be compensated at the rate of \$100.00 for each day spent attending training required by law or by the board.

(4) The chairperson and each member of the board shall also be reimbursed for actual expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the performance of their duties.

(5) All such compensation and expenses provided for in this subsection shall be paid from the funds of the Evans County School District."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021.

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
