A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, approved  
2 December 3, 1880 (Ga. L. 1880-81, p. 508), as amended, particularly by an Act approved  
3 May 2, 2017 (Ga. L. 2017, p. 3635), so as to provide for compensation of the chairperson and  
4 other members of the board of commissioners; to provide for related matters; to provide for  
5 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, approved December 3, 1880  
9 (Ga. L. 1880-81, p. 508), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 2, 2017  
10 (Ga. L. 2017, p. 3635), is amended by adding a new subsection to Section 3 as follows:

11 "(e)(1) The full-time chairperson shall receive for service as chairperson a base salary  
12 equal to 100 percent of the annual salary for a chief magistrate judge in a county with the  
13 population of Fulton County as set by general state law.

14 (2) Each member of the board of commissioners, other than the chairperson, shall receive  
15 as his or her base compensation for service a salary equal to 60 percent of the base salary  
16 of the chairperson."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
