## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life and memory of Randall Keith Redding; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia mourns the loss of one of its most distinguished citizens  
3 with the passing of Randall Keith Redding on March 8, 2021; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Randall Keith Redding was born on October 20, 1954, in Bremen, Georgia, a  
5 beloved son of the late Guy and Mildred Redding; and
- 6 WHEREAS, a dedicated and devoted provider and protector as a husband, father, and  
7 grandfather, Randall was united in love and marriage to his wife, Tena, and was blessed with  
8 two remarkable children, Keith (and Brooke) Redding and Ivey Redding, and four wonderful  
9 grandchildren, Cindi Claire, Tripp, Livi, and Lila; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he had a long and successful career in construction, founding R.K. Redding  
11 Construction in 1991 which employs 50 full-time employees and more than 100 contractors  
12 in West Georgia; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Randall's exemplary industry and community contributions earned him many  
14 recognitions, including the AGC Georgia SIR Award, the Bremen Circle of Honor, a feature

15 as a top male business leader in *The Man's Issue*, and the Carroll County Chamber of  
16 Commerce Business of the Year Award in 2020; and

17 WHEREAS, Randall's lifelong love of music led him to convert an abandoned grocery store  
18 into a successful music venue known as Mill Town Music Hall; and

19 WHEREAS, a man of deep and abiding faith, Randall was an active member of Mt. Paran  
20 Church in Atlanta, Georgia, where he also served as a member on the Board of Trustees; and

21 WHEREAS, Randall gave inspiration to many through his high ideals, morals, and love for  
22 his fellow citizens, and the devotion, patience, and understanding he demonstrated to his  
23 family and friends were admired by others; and

24 WHEREAS, he was a person of extreme generosity in support of the Lord's Kingdom and  
25 the community, and through the example of his life, he made this world a better place in  
26 which to live; and

27 WHEREAS, a compassionate and generous man, Randall Keith Redding will long be  
28 remembered for his love of family, friendship, and community and will be missed by all who  
29 had the great fortune of knowing him.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
31 join in honoring the life and memory of Randall Keith Redding and express their deepest and  
32 most sincere regret at his passing.
